This workshop will give students an introduction into the practice and theory of visual communication and design. It will show the possibilities of computer-based graphical user interface and how to apply them. Using examples from current AHRC supported projects it will enable to students to take advantage of resources and technologies of information materialisation and visualisation. It will facilitate the creation of augmented artefacts and lead into hybrid creative practices such as design for museum interaction, interactive installations and augmented reality for mobile devices.

It will encourage students to incorporate visual communication design practices into their research and highlight how this can foster trans-disciplinary research .
